

DanceSport Tasmania Hall of Fame



Who is eligible?

To be considered a person must meet the following criteria:

- Have achieved outstanding performance in DanceSport competition while either identifying themselves as Tasmanian or acknowledging Tasmania as their home
- Have achieved outstanding commitment to DanceSport outside of competition while either identifying themselves as Tasmanian or acknowledging Tasmania as their home
- Have exhibited a standard of behaviour that is fair, ethical and above reproach in relation to the rules and regulations of their sport and the communities expectations

Selections will be made from as far back as records allow.

It should be noted that:

- Posthumous nominations will be accepted.
- Candidates currently dancing competitively or participating in any aspect of DanceSport such as coaching, adjudicating or studio management **are** eligible to be nominated for the Hall of Fame.

Judging:

Nominations will be considered by the Tasmanian DanceSport Hall of Fame Judging Panel that will make a recommendation to the Board.

This panel will comprise:

- The Chair or the Executive Officer of the Tasmanian DanceSport Board;
- A representative from the directors and executive of national DanceSport who is not a member of the Tasmanian Board; and
- A representative from the State government department responsible for the Tasmanian Sport Hall of Fame.

The judging panel's decisions are final and no communication will be entered into regarding the judging of the nominations.

How to submit:

Nominations can be made by filling in a nomination form available on the DanceSport Tasmania website.

Nominations must be submitted to the Executive Officer, DanceSport Tasmania, by June 30th of the year of nomination.

No late nominations will be accepted

Announcement

The successful Hall of Fame recipient will be announced at the Tasmanian Open DanceSport Championships.

Nominators will be advised of the outcome of their nomination prior to this event.
